Vail Resorts Reports Ski Resort Attendance

The number of skiers that visit Vail, Beaver Creek, Breckenridge, and Keystone no longer depend on the amount of snowfall, according to Vail Resorts. Instead, the economy is the largest influence on ski visitation. Vail Resorts have chosen to invest in snowmaking, season pass sales, and high-end clientele to boost resort revenue. This past year, lift ticket sales were up 8%, the number of skiers was up 3.9%, and dining revenues were up 9%. In addition, rental and retail revenues were up 8.3% as well. Vail Resorts have positioned their resorts as high-end ski destinations.
